Commissioners led everyone present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Road and Bridge report:

- Interim Road Supervisor, John Schouten, reported that he is in the process of getting bids on cattle guards.
- Schouten discussed the work on DD250th bridge.
- Snell Bridge will need to have the southwest side built up.
- Schouten discussed that the compacter is down at this time and will be trying to get it repaired.
- The bridge going into Piedmont has been cleaned out and needs to have a new tinhorn.
- The bridge at 60th west of J, is need some dozer repair work on it.
- Schouten is looking for a trailer.
- Looking at tree removal and clipper grinding them up.

Special Payables in the amount of \$50,000.00 was approved with Commissioner Evenson making the motion and Commissioner Fox seconded for roof replacement on the Courthouses north end. Motion carried 5-0.

Shelly Hoyt and Stacy Randle with USD 389 addressed the commissioner on the issues of recycling. Hoyt said the price of recycling is high but a price tag cannot be put on future. Hoyt asking commissioners to rethink the ending of the recycling program. Randle told the commissioners she would be happy to look for grants to help pay for the recycling.
