

Chairman Ben Fox called the regular meeting of the Greenwood County Commissioners to order at 9:00 a.m. Other members present were Roy Ballard, Paul Hodge, Mac Obourn, Preston Evenson, County Counselor Paul Dean, and Deputy County Clerk Deann McCaffree.

Commissioners led everyone present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Ballard moved to approve June 24th, 2024 minutes as written. Obourn seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

Hodge moved to approve July 1st, 2024 minutes as written. Ballard seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

Road and Bridge report:

- Road and Bridge Supervisor, Allen Greenwood presented drafted plans from Engineer Michael Maris to improve the condition of the crossing on 60th St.
- Greenwood informed commissioners he would be meeting with Maris to inspect a bridge on K Rd. and discuss the best way to fix the road washing out.
- Discussion from previous meetings continued regarding a trailer.
- Ballard requested that Greenwood look at culverts at 375th and X road.

Obourn moved to approve Special Payables in the amount of \$11,933.73. Ballard seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

Obourn moved to approve Payables in the amount \$173,331.02. Evenson seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

Evenson moved to approve Payroll in the amount of \$157,244.10. Ballard seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

County land owner, Shilo Fury attended the commission meeting to follow-up on K Road. The Greenwood/Elk County line road runs along Fury's property. Commissioners discussed the possibility of lowering the road width. Commissioners also discussed if the road was township responsibility. Dean suggested coordinating with Elk County regarding the situation.

Noxious weed Director, Jennifer West presented quotes from Fairbanks, the first quote is to do a rebuild on the spray truck, this would include new hoses, flow meter, crank bearings and another boom. Existing equipment is from 2008. The second quote from Fairbanks, is for a skid for the Chevy. It would include a new tank, and new computer to run the boom. Ordering the parts needed for the spray truck and having the work done internally was also discussed. Commissioners decided check into things further and revisit the spray truck rebuild at a later time. (JE24-66, JE24-67)

Eureka City Administrator, Joel Laws reminded commissioners about the small business administration meeting on July 11, 2024.

Fox moved to approve a five-minute executive session with Road and Bridge Supervisor, Allen Greenwood regarding legal. Ballard seconded motion carried 5-0. Meeting to reconvene at 10:05. No decisions were made.

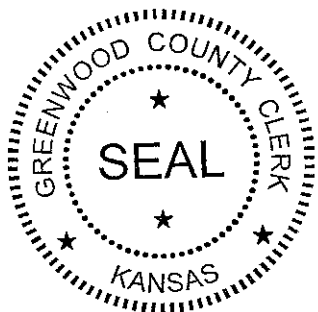
