Chairman Ben Fox called the regular meeting of the Greenwood County Commissioners to order at 9:00 a.m. Other members present were Roy Ballard, Paul Hodge, Mac Obourn, County Counselor Paul Dean and County Clerk Deann McCaffree

Commissioners led everyone present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Hodge moved to approve August 5th, 2024 minutes as written. Ballard seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

Hodge moved to approve special payables in the amount of \$1,152.82. Ballard seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

Ballard moved to approve payables in the amount of \$208,591.97. Obourn seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

Obourn moved to approve payroll in the amount of \$155,629.98. Hodge seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

County Counselor Paul Dean informed commissioners' that the minimum maintenance roads that needed approved were being compiled into one legal document. Emergency Management Director, Levi Vinson stated he is checking to be sure that none of the roads on the list have been approved in the past.

Fox moved to approve Staci Crumrine for the Treasurers office at \$15.00 hr. Ballard seconded, Motion Carried 4-3.

Obourn moved to approve Paige Neighbors for the Register of Deeds, office clerk at \$14.50 hr. Hodge seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

Register of Deeds Marsha Ramsey discussed with commissioners that herself, other staff members and commissioners are bonded. Ramsey asked commissioners if they knew what the coverage was for this, she also asked how much legal counsel \$10,000.00 would cover. It was noted this amount has not changed in 23 years. Dean commented the he believed KCAMP would cover more than the \$10000.00. This item was going to be checked on.

Hodge questioned the need for surveying Q Rd./90<sup>th</sup> St. and 150<sup>th</sup>/U Rd. and the cost. Vinson noted they were looking into the survey for safety reasons, due to the change of traffic flow. Vinson informed commissioners that Engineer Michael Maris was going to e-mail estimates.
