Collinge presented two bids, one from Ramsey Concrete for \$20,400.00 that includes a 5-inch thick, 40ft x 60 ft concrete pad, with #4 rebar. And a bid from Ross Anello for \$19,200.00 that includes the 40ft x 60ft concrete pad with wire mat reinforcement. It was noted the facility would be beneficial to other counties also. (JE24-90, JE24-91)

Obourn moved to approve a bid from Ramsey Concrete for \$20,400.00. Hodge seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

Health Department Director Vicki Lindsey presented a bid of \$1899.45 for a new vaccine freezer, a grant would possibly be available to help with the purchase. It was also noted the state would need to approve the unit. Lindsey stated the freezer the health department has is over ten years old, and the state prefers they are less than that.

Obourn moved to approve a vaccine freezer, pending the grant and the states approval. Fox seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

Fox moved to approve a ten-executive session with Road and Bridge Supervisor, Allen Greenwood for legal. Ballard seconded. Motion carried 4-0. Reconvened at 9:50. No decisions.

Fox moved to approve a five-minute break. Ballard seconded. Motion carried 4-0. Reconvened at 9:55.

Ballard moved to approve Special Payables in the amount of \$89.74. Hodge seconded. Motion carried 4-0.
