

Ben Fox called the regular meeting of the Greenwood County Commissioners to order at 9:00 a.m. Other members present were Mac Obourn, Preston Evenson, Roy Ballard, County Counselor Paul Dean and County Clerk Deann McCaffree.

Commissioners led everyone present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Ballard moved to approve November 25, 2024 minutes as written. Evenson seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

Road and Bridge Report:

- Road and Bridge Supervisor, Allen Greenwood presented the contract from Cook, Flatt, and Strobe to repair the J Rd. and 250th St. bridge (Nordmeyer Bridge)
- Greenwood informed commissioners he would be meeting with a new FEMA representative Dec 3, 2024 to continue with the process for the April flood event.

Obourn moved to approve special payables in the amount of \$89.74. Evenson seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

Evenson moved to approve year end bonuses in the amount of \$150.00 for full-time employees and \$75.00 for part-time employees. Obourn seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

Fox moved to approve a 10-minute executive session for legal with Road and Bridge Supervisor, Allen Greenwood. Ballard seconded. Motion carried 4-0. Reconvened at 9:37. No decisions.

Fox moved to approve five-minute executive session with Maintenance supervisor, Greg Rawlings for employee performance. Evenson seconded. Motion carried 4-0. Reconvened at 9:42. No decisions.

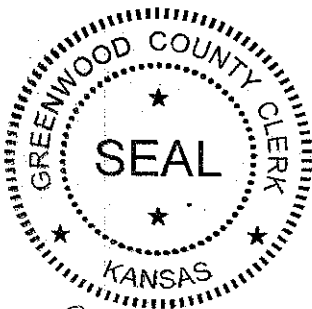

Rawlings discussed sewer system issues he believed were under the jail. It was noted there was not a ground cleanout, just sewer access on the roof. Rawlings noted he received a quote for a bore scope to be ran to check sewer lines and is looking into other options.

Fox moved to approve a ten-minute executive session for legal. Ballard seconded. Motion carried. Reconvened at 10:00. No decisions.

Lack of attendance at the end of the year dinner was discussed. Commissioners asked McCaffree to check with department heads as to whether an end of the year dinner, and half a day off or a added bonus of \$25.00 and work till 5pm was wanted.

Evenson moved to adjourn at 10:09. Obourn seconded. Motion carried 4-0.
