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Commission Chair, Mac Obourn, called the regular meeting of the Greenwood County Commissioners to order at 9:00 a.m. Other members present were Preston Evenson, Roy Ballard, Ron Mast, Judd Everitt, County Counselor Paul Dean and County Clerk Deann McCaffree.

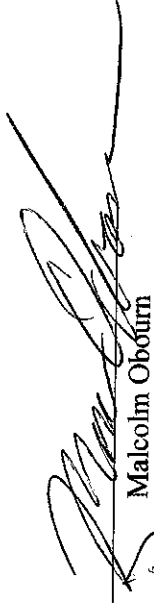
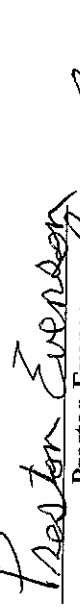
Ballard moved to approve a ten minute executive for Legal with Greenwood. Everitt seconded. Motion carried 5-0. Return @ 10:20a.m.

Commissioner Evenson gave a short report on the Kansas County Commissioners State Conference that he attended last week.

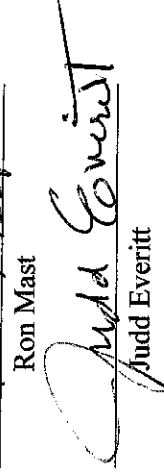
Evenson moved to adjourn at 10:24a.m.. Ballard seconded. Motion carried 5-0.
