

GREENWOOD COUNTY COMMISSION MEETING

JULY 14TH, 2025

Commission Chair, Mac Obourn, called the regular meeting of the Greenwood County Commissioners to order at 9:00 a.m. Other members present were Roy Ballard, Ron Mast, Judd Everitt, Preston Evenson, County Clerk Deann McCaffree and County Counselor Paul Dean.

Commissioners led everyone present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Ballard moved to approve July 7th, 2025 minutes as written. Evenson seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

Commissioner Evenson presented Treasure Olson with Plaque Recognizing 40 years of her service.

Claims:

Everitt moved to approve Special Payables for July 21st, 2025 in the amount of \$2,059.50. Evenson seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

New Business:

- Health Officer / Administrator Lewis presented a contract for the medical director position. Lewis notes that the annual contract needed a signature and it was the same as past years.
Commissioners approved by signing.

Road and Bridge:

- K. Lazar gave a brief report stating that she has spoken with Severy City Clerk Tessa Riggs regarding 700 feet of Water Street in Severy that both entities certainly share. Lazar stated that the City of Severy was willing to take full responsibility of the remaining portion and claim it as their own rather than share it 50/50. It was noted that the city has been maintaining the roadway and will continue to do so.
- Lazar also brought up about the clean out of the bridges and culverts throughout the county. Commissioners Everitt and Ballard said they had looked at bridges in the northern part of the county, near EE Road and suggested obtaining a bid for repairs through Ramsey Concrete.
- Ballard made a discussion about making sure there was additional time that was spent cleaning out the bridges and culverts.

Paul Dean reported about the Greenwood County Board of Health, statute 65-201 defines for medical director contract.

Old Business:

- Commissioner Obourn asked Counselor Dean about the Tax Sale and estimated date.

Evenson moved to adjourn at 9:30a.m. Mast seconded. Motion carried 5-0.
