Commission Chair, Mac Obourn, called the regular meeting of the Greenwood County Commissioners to order at 9:00 a.m. Other members present were Roy Ballard, Ron Mast, Judd Everitt, Preston Evenson, County Clerk Deann McCaffree and County Counselor Paul Dean.

Commissioners led everyone present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Everitt moved to approve June 16th, 2025 minutes as written. Mast seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

Road and Bridge:
