

GREENWOOD COUNTY COMMISSION MEETING

AUGUST 18TH, 2025

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Commission Chair, Mac Obourn, called the regular meeting of the Greenwood County Commissioners to order at 9:00 a.m. Other members present were Roy Ballard, Ron Mast, Judd Everitt, Preston Evenson, County Clerk Deann McCaffree and County Counselor Paul Dean.

Commissioners led everyone present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Ballard moved to approve August 11th, 2025 minutes as written. Everitt seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

Road and Bridge:

- Administrative Assistant Kassi Lazar reported that FEMA had reached back out to the county, noting that if the county moved forward with the mitigation process, FEMA would reimburse the county \$13,000 for the cross-engineering plans.

Obourn made a motion to proceed with the mitigation process. Evenson seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

- *Greenwood stated the New Lift was received for the shop.*

Claims:

Ballard moved to approve Special Payables for August 18th, 2025 in the amount of \$2,400.62. Ballard seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

Everitt moved to approve Regular Payables for August 22nd in the amount of \$277,450.42. Evenson Seconded. Motion Carried 5-0.

Obourn moved to approve Payroll for August 22nd in the amount of \$163,785.46. Mast seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

Clerk:

- County Clerk Deann McCaffree presented 90-day review for Ashley Nichols and asked for \$1.50/hr raise.

Evenson made a motion to approve the \$1.50/hr raise fore Ashley Nichols. Mast seconded motion carried 5-0.

New Business:

- Kurly Hebb addressed about fencing issue near 2775 50th street in Fall River. Hebb requested a fence viewing which was scheduled for Monday Sept. 8th at 11 am.

Old Business:

- Water Street Agreement with City of Severy

Obourn motion to approve the agreement with the City of Severy. Ballard seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

- EMS Director Brian Mongeau brought up the ongoing Granite invoices. The contract will not be renewed and the bills will cease once the contract has been completed.

Evenson moved for a 15-minute Executive session legal. Ballard seconded. Motion carried 5-0. Return at 10:02am. No decisions.

Counselor Dean noted that he expects the county tax sale to be held in the first half of October.

Ballard moved to adjourn at 10:11 a.m. Everitt seconded. Motion carried 5-0.
