

GREENWOOD COUNTY COMMISSION MEETING

JANUARY 12TH, 2026

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Commission Chair Preston Evenson, called the regular meeting of the Greenwood County Commissioners to order at 9:00 a.m. Other members present were Roy Ballard, Ron Mast, Judd Everitt, Mac Obourn, County Counselor Paul Dean, and County Clerk Deann McCaffree.

Commissioners led everyone present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Obourn moved to approve January 5th, 2026 minutes as written. Ballard seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

Clerks Agenda:

- County Clerk Deann McCaffree presented two CMB license (one for consumption on premise and one for sales out the door) for Tri-Corner. for approval.

Obourn moved to approve both CMB licenses (one for consumption on premise and one for sales out the door) for Tri-Corner. Mast seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

Claims:

Obourn moved to approve Special Payables for January 5, 2026 in the amount of \$9,046.09. Everitt seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

Executive sessions:

Obourn motioned for a 15-minute executive session for personnel with Maintenance Director Greg Rawlings. Ballard seconded. Motion carried 5-0. Return at 9:24 a.m. No decisions.

Obourn motioned for a 10-minute legal executive session for facilities management insurance claims with County Counselor Paul Dean and Maintenance Director Greg Rawlings. Ballard seconded. Motion carried 5-0. Return at 9:36 a.m. No decisions.

New Business:

- Sheriff Heath Samuels presented a 2-year renewal contract with Crosswinds Counseling and Wellness for employees in his department for signatures. The commissioners signed the contract.
- Commissioner Judd Everitt spoke with Greenwood County Hospital CEO Sandra Dickerson (attended via zoom) regarding questions and concerns he has been asked from Greenwood County residence concerning bills being turned into collections.
- County Clerk presented Resolution 25-58 for approval. This resolution pertains to the court system's year-end transfers.

Obourn motioned to approve Resolution 25-58. Everitt seconded. Motioned carried 5-0.

Obourn motioned for a 5-minute break. Ballard seconded. Motioned carried 5-0. Return at 9:57 a.m.

Executive sessions:

Obourn motioned for a 15-minute legal executive session for personnel complaint with County Counselor Paul Dean and County Appraiser Shawn Griffiths. Mast seconded. Motion carried 5-0. Return at 10:14 a.m. No decisions.

New Business:

- Emergency Management Levi Vinson let the commissioners know that he would be attending a meeting/training/exercise in Norman Oklahoma on February 4, 2026. Vinson let them know he would be going down the night before and staying.
- Commissioners appointed Eureka Township Board officers. Everitt will be the Trustee, Obourn will be the Treasurer, and Evenson will be the Clerk.

Obourn motioned for a 5-minute legal executive session with County Counselor Paul Dean. Ballard seconded. Motion carried 5-0. Return at 10:27 a.m. No decisions.
