Commission Chair Preston Evenson, called the regular meeting of the Greenwood County Commissioners to order at 9:00 a.m. Other members present were Roy Ballard, Ron Mast, Judd Everitt, Mac Obourn, County Counselor Paul Dean, and County Clerk Deann McCaffree.

Commissioners led everyone present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

***Ballard moved to approve January 26th, 2026 minutes as written. Mast seconded. Motion carried 5-0.***

***Road and Bridge:***

- Greenwood County Road and Bridge Supervisor Allen Greenwood presented a bid for Ivanpah Crossing demo and repair by Ramsey Concrete for \$16,400.

***Obourn motioned to approve the bid for Ivanpah Crossing from Ramsey Concrete for \$16,400. Everitt seconded. Motion carried 5-0.***

- Greenwood County Road and Bridge Supervisor Allen Greenwood presented a bid for Allison Crossing repair by Ramsey Concrete for \$49,100.

***Everitt motioned to approve the bid for Allison Crossing from Ramsey Concrete for \$49,100. Obourn seconded. Motion carried 5-0.***

- Greenwood County Maintenance Supervisor Greg Rawlings presented bids for a sound system for the commissioner's room.

***Everitt motioned to approve the purchase of option 1 from eBay for \$1,577.02. Ballard seconded. Motion carried 5-0.***

***New Business:***

- Greenwood County Maintenance Supervisor Greg Rawlings advised the commissioners that the State of Kansas requires the state Fire Marshall to do inspections for the elevator. Rawlings said this is all new legislation as of a couple of years ago. Rawlings said the State is going to mandate a third party to do an inspection of an existing system. Rawlings said received a recommendation to use Maverick Elevator Inspections out of Mulvane Ks. Rawlings said this will cost approximately \$400. Rawlings said the inspection would be good for three years at this time unless something changes.
- Greenwood County Health Department Supervisor Jayme Lewis let the commissioners know that her office will be closed Thursday, February 5, 2026 from 7:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. for staff to attend a Regional Public Health Emergency Preparedness Exercise in Emporia Ks.
