

**GREENWOOD COUNTY COMMISSION MEETING**

Vice-Commission Chair Judd Everitt, called the regular meeting of the Greenwood County Commissioners to order at 9:00 a.m. Other members present were Roy Ballard, Ron Mast, Mac Obourn, County Counselor Paul Dean, and County Clerk Deann McCaffree. Absent – Preston Evenson

Commissioners led everyone present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

*Obourn moved to approve February 23rd, 2026 minutes as written. Ballard seconded. Motion carried 4-0.*

**Road and Bridge:**

- The commissioners spoke with Road and Bridge administrative assistant Kassie Lazar regarding the delivery of the skid steer, grader and the bridge at 130<sup>th</sup> street. Lazar advised the new grader should arrive by the end of next week. Lazar advised no known delivery date for skid steer at this time.

**Clerk's Agenda:**

- Debbie Selfridge with Noxious Weed presented the 2026 Management Plan and the Annual Noxious Weed Eradication Progress Report to the commissioners for approval and signatures.

*Obourn moved to approve the 2026 Management Plan and Annual Noxious Weed Eradication Progress Report. Ballard seconded. Motion carried 4-0.*

- County Clerk Deann McCaffree presented new hire full time Linton for Accounts Payable position at \$16.48 per hour.

**Claims:**

*Ballard moved to approve Special Payables for March 2, 2026 in the amount of \$2,660.60. Obourn seconded. Motion carried 4-0.*

*Obourn moved to approve Regular Payables for March 6, 2026 in the amount of \$307,181.10. Mast seconded. Motion carried 4-0.*

*Mast moved to approve Payroll for March 6, 2026 in the amount of \$160,983.03. Ballard seconded. Motion carried 4-0.*

**New Business:**

- Sheriff Heath Samuels spoke with the commissioners regarding a budgeting training class that Health Department Director Jayme Lewis is putting together. Samuels said they are looking to having it at the library so department heads can attend.
- Commissioner Judd Everitt spoke regarding the hospital board meetings. Everitt advised the hospital has received the new mammogram machine and a new CFO.
- Sheriff Heath Samuels, Emergency Management Director Levi Vinson and the Commissioners discussed township budgeting and possible consolidation.

**Old Business:**

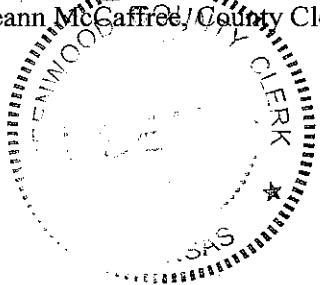
