

GREENWOOD COUNTY COMMISSION MEETING

APRIL 27TH, 2026

Commission Chair Preston Evenson, called the regular meeting of the Greenwood County Commissioners to order at 9:00 a.m. Other members present were Judd Everitt, Roy Ballard, Ron Mast, Mac Obourn, County Counselor Paul Dean, and County Clerk Deann McCaffree.

Commissioners led everyone present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Ballard moved to approve April 20th, 2026 minutes as written. Mast seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

Road and Bridge:

- Administrative Assistant Kassie Lazar presented 3 bids for truck and trailer tires to the commissioners. 1st bid was from T&W Tire for \$11,499.65. 2nd bid was from West Creek Repair for \$15,950.00 and the 3rd bid was from Rock's 54 for \$13,125.00. It was noted by Commissioner Ballard that he had not heard of the brand of tire T&W presented the bid on.

Obourn motioned to approve the bid from Rock's 54 for \$13,125.00. Everitt seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

Claims:

Obourn moved to approve Special Payables for April 27, 2026 in the amount of \$2,774.06. Mast seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

Ballard moved to approve Regular Payables for May 1, 2026 in the amount of \$149,219.01. Everitt seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

Obourn moved to approve Payroll for May 1, 2026 in the amount of \$172,327.06. Mast seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

Old Business:

- The commissioners received a road closing petition for a dead-end road at N Road South of 75th in Otter Creek Township East.

Obourn motioned to accept the road closing petition for N Road South of 75th in Otter Creek Township East a dead-end road. Ballard seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

Road viewing is scheduled for May 18, 2026 at 11 a.m.

- Noxious Weed Director Debbie Selfridge was not present at the meeting to present truck bids.
- No discussion was held regarding the pay scale at this meeting.

New Business:

- Donald Pennington addressed the commissioners regarding trees over the road way in the Salt Springs Township. Don Bosken addressed the commissioners regarding the trees as well as the trees are on his property. Bosken had questions regarding property lines in his area. The commissioners advised both Pennington and Bosken that this would be up to the township board, not a county matter as the county does not maintain the roads in townships.
- County Clerk Deann McCaffree and County Treasure Stacie Pearse addressed the commissioners regarding their departments needing a reliable vehicle to take out of town to meetings and trainings. Commissioners advised McCaffree and Pearse to look at cost of a four-door car.
- Emergency Management Director Levi Vinson addressed the commissioners for approval to pay a bill from Genasys for the public safety program for \$2,677.00.

Obourn motioned to pay the bill from Genasys for \$2,677.00. Everitt seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

Executive Session:

Obourn motioned for a 10-minute legal executive session for department management with County Counselor Paul Dean. Mast seconded. Motion carried 5-0. Return at 9:49 a.m. No decisions.
