Commission Chair Preston Evenson, called the regular meeting of the Greenwood County Commissioners to order at 9:00 a.m. Other members present were Judd Everitt, Roy Ballard, Ron Mast, Mac Obourn, County Counselor Paul Dean, and County Clerk Deann McCaffree.

Commissioners led everyone present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Obourn moved to approve corrected minutes for May 4, 2026. Everitt seconded. Motion carried 5-0. Everitt moved to approve May 11th, 2026 minutes as written. Obourn seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

Road and Bridge:

- Road & Bridge Supervisor, Allen Greenwood relayed that the new skid steer will be delivered this week.
- Commissioners notified that a bridge on R25 Rd north of 350th has a hole in it, needs inspected.
- Commissioner Evenson asked if the county still sprays for Townships. The answer is NO.

Clerk's Agenda:

- Cereal Malt Beverage License for Eureka Lakeside Treasures

- Brown also asked about the Tower behind the hospital. Sheriff Samuels will look into the information needed.
- Cinda Beal, Gw Co Hospital Board of Trustees Chairperson, in attendance to answer questions for the Hospital Board financials. Meetings are 4th Thursday of the month.
- Miranda Colangelo requested financial reports for the Hospital and discussed accounting procedures for public entities.
- Emergency Manager, Levi Vinson, gave an update for Fire Chief Glen Collinge on responding to the fires in western Kansas.
