Commission Chair Preston Evenson, called the regular meeting of the Greenwood County Commissioners to order at 9:00 a.m. Other members present were Judd Everitt, Roy Ballard, Ron Mast, Mac Obourn, County Counselor Paul Dean, and County Clerk Deann McCaffree.

Commissioners led everyone present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Ballard moved to approve corrected minutes for May 18, 2026. Obourn seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

Obourn made motion for a 5-minute break. Mast seconded. Motion carried 5-0. Return at 10:32 a.m.

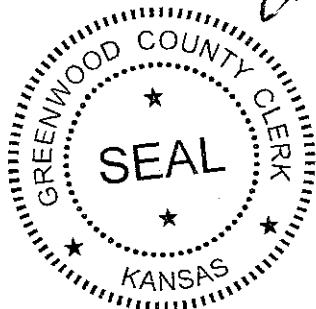
Executive Session:
